I reviewed the recent reports submitted, one of the soil borings advanced near the former waste oil tank pit and the other of soil samples collected along the former railroad spur. In addition, I reviewed the case closure summary prepared for the closure of USTs removed in 1991. It appears that closure was granted for commercial use of the site.

Current RWQCB policy states that unless the site meets all potential future use of the site, a deed restriction would be required. Residual benzene in soil at approximately 10 feet bgs exceeds the RWQCB's Tier 1 RBSLs for residential use. I strongly recommend that soil vapor samples be collected near the former waste oil tank pit, and if analytical results are less than the applicable RBSLs, the case can be closed w/o a deed restriction.

Let's discuss this or submit a work plan for the collection of soil vapor samples.

Based upon our conversation Friday, I am faxing over a copy of a soil delineation plan for the railroad track spur. We will take samples within ten and twenty five feet from the spur. We will sample to a depth of two feet with samples collected at one and two feet. The samples at twenty five feet will be placed on hold pending the closer samples. The samples will be analyzed for PCBs, lead and arsenic. We will use the northwestern sample as a background point, since it is away from the track spur and less likely to be impacted by activities associated with the spur.

Our client prefers to use encapsulation with asphalt or concrete rather than soil removal. They have received the deed restriction form.


