Workplan to Define Lateral Extent of Petroleum Hydrocarbons at Excavation D

762 Stewart Court, Alameda, California

Dear Mr. Chan:

Per your request in the October 27, 2003 letter to Ms. Patricia Santanna, RMT, Inc. (RMT) proposes to collect additional soil samples to define the lateral extent of residual petroleum hydrocarbons in soil in the vicinity of Excavation D (Figure 1). A single soil sample will be collected from each of five soil borings shown in Figure 1. After the five soil samples have been collected, temporary well casings will be placed in two soil borings, and a total of two grab groundwater samples will be collected (Figure 1).

Soil samples will be collected at a depth of approximately 6 feet below ground surface. The soil samples will be collected in brass liners and sealed with plastic caps and Teflon liners. Soil and grab groundwater samples, and a trip blank water sample will be then transported to Curtis & Tompkins, a state-certified analytical laboratory, under chain-of-custody for TPH as motor oil analysis using EPA Method 8015.

Once the lateral extent of petroleum hydrocarbons has been defined at Excavation D, and the groundwater quality has been documented, you will issue a letter of no further action to Ms. Patricia Santanna for the 762 Stewart Court property in Alameda, California.
