Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Responsible Party Identification

Existence of Unauthorized Release

Three 1000-gallon, two 8000-gallon, and two 7500-gallon underground fuel storage tanks (UST) were removed from the site in April 1987. In August 2002, analyses of shallow groundwater samples from six borings drilled in the vicinity of the tanks had reported concentrations of gasoline constituents and diesel range hydrocarbons. In June 2004, analyses of shallow groundwater samples from eight borings, three drilled at the locations of former USTs and five drilled in close proximity of suspected UST locations, had reported concentrations of gasoline constituents and diesel range hydrocarbons.

Responsible Party Identification

Pacific Pipe Company owned the property from circa 1940 till May 15, 2006. Pacific Pipe Company is a responsible party because it owned the USTs (definition 1), formerly owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (definition 3), and had control over the USTs at the time of or following the unauthorized release (definition 4).

Capitol Stone Group, LLC, purchased the property on May 15, 2006. Capitol Stone Group, LLC is a responsible party because it owns the property where an unauthorized release occurred (definition 3).
