

This letter is to inform you of the current status of the environmental investigation at the above referenced site. As you are aware, Alameda County Environmental Health had originally been requested to oversee the investigation and potential remediation of the petroleum material at this site. This material appeared on the surface, in the northeast corner of this site. We found out that this material may be the residual contamination from the former J. H. Baxter wood treatment plant. The suspicion is that the J.H. Baxter site occupied a large area, including that which is currently the 5A Rent A Space facility. We have received a work plan from Hygienetics Environmental that proposes excavation and soil and groundwater sampling in the northeast corner of the 5A Rent A Space.

Our office has met with the Department of Toxic Substances (DTSC) and they have expressed interest in overseeing the investigation and cleanup of the former J. H. Baxter site. In fact, DTSC has taken samples at 5A Rent A Space to verify that the contamination found would be appropriate for their oversight. Upon confirmation, it is anticipated that DTSC will provide oversight for all parcels affected by releases from the former J. H. Baxter site. Thus, our office shall not be responding to the Hygienetics Environmental work plan. To expedite restoration of the 5A Rent A Space facility, you may wish to resurface the site and take samples, however, it is uncertain what DTSC will require at this time.
