The referenced site is a Spills, Leaks, Investigations, and Cleanup (SLIC) case due to the presence of soil and groundwater contamination on the property. Alameda County Environmental Health is the agency providing regulatory oversight for this case. Our records indicate that the current balance on the above-referenced SLIC oversight account is a \$629.00. In order for ACEH to complete the regulatory review and closure process, we require an additional deposit to an oversight account.
