Thank you for the submittal of Kleinfelder's June 1996 Risk-Based Cleanup Levels Analysis Report for the above referenced site. And as stated in this Agency's letter dated June 13, 1996, contamination identified in groundwater does not appear to pose a threat to human health based on current land use and that the site will be capped. Therefore, no further action related to the solvent and petroleum hydrocarbons identified is required.

A total of fifteen (15) hours was spent overseeing this case to site closure. Our oversight fees amounted to \$1,350.00 (at \$90.00 per hour). A total of \$1,000 have been received from Kleinfelder. A balance of \$350.00 is currently due. Please make checks payable to Alameda, Treasurer.

Dear Eva:

After our telephone conversation last week, and a second conversation Wednesday, May 22, 1996, I have attempted to gather some background information on the above referenced facility. Amerco Real Estate acquired the property as vacant land. The northern portion was sub-divided and sold, also vacant. The Kleinfelder report you provided to me indicated that we started to construct a building on the property before it was sold. This is not what occurred. I have interviewed an U-Haul employee who was the original manager at the U-Haul facility, and is still actively involved with the site. After that interview, I have discovered that when the property was sold by U-Haul, the property was vacant save for a small concrete pad which was poured around an anti-siphon valve in the city water line which crosses the property. In addition, our facility was immediately paved, after purchase, and has been since this first occurred. Also, the Kleinfelder report indicates that U-Haul property surrounds the property in question (on both the South and West sides). The property to the West is not U-Haul property. This is the El Monte site, which is an RV storage, sales, and repair facility.

Immediately to the East of our facility, across Scarlet Drive, is an auto dealer with repair facilities, the Valley Auto Center. North of that is the Chemical Waste Management Recycle facility. To the North of that is a vacant lot. North of that (directly East of the J. Patrick Land site) is an abandoned industrial facility.

When the tank pull was being conducted at our facility my consultant, Maxxim Environmental, noticed several pits that had been excavated at the abandoned industrial facility. In addition, several 55 gallon drums were observed on site near the excavations. There was also yellow "caution tape" surrounding the excavation area, as though there was some sort of clean up underway.

After careful consideration, I feel U-Haul is not justified in committing to the additional expense, and liability of volunteering to place additional borings, separate from the UST issue, on site. I have come to this conclusion for several reasons:

- 1. The regional groundwater flow as interpreted by Kleinfelder is to the southwest, and is interpreted by Maxxim from the tank pull activities as to the South. Our facility is located down gradient of the area found to be contaminated.
- 2. No reportable amounts of the chemicals of concern were ever used at out facility.
- 3. An apparent remediation project is currently under way immediately up gradient of the area discovered to be contaminated.

- 4. Two vehicle repair facilities surround the subject property, both of which could have contributed to the contamination.
- 5. A chemical waste management facility is located adjacent to the subject property.
- 6. Past activities on the subject property, could have included among other things, vehicular or equipment maintenance. This is a probable source for solvents.
- 7. Conflict of interest problems with using multiple consultants, and shared samples with different clients, with possible adversarial roles.

I feel that U-Haul/Amerco is an innocent land owner in this matter. And that we have possibly been adversely impacted by the activities of a neighbor. We are willing to assist in the investigation and delineation of the contaminant plume. We will grant permission for Kleinfelder to place borings on our property, and allow them access to sample ground water if permanent wells are installed.

Dear Messrs. Neighbor and Moore:

I have completed review of Kleinfelder's March 1996 Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Report, and May 1996 Environmental Investigation Report for the above referenced site. Both reports confirm that a solvent and hydrocarbon plume exists in groundwater in the southwest portion of the parcel. Up to 66 parts per billion tetrachloroethene (ppb PCE) and 1,400 ppb total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel have been identified. The source and extent of the plume have not been determined.

Based on the data submitted and current land use, the level of contaminants identified during the recent investigations does not appear to pose a risk to human health. This Agency does not object to the development of the parcel at this time. However, site closure cannot be granted until the source and/or extent of the plume has been fully characterized.

Dedication of Water Line Essenant to DOSLIN


