This letter confirms the completion of a site investigation and remedial action for the elevated lead concentrations found in surface soil at the above referenced site. Three residential housing units are proposed to be constructed at the site.

Remedial activities were conducted in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) approved by this agency on November 14, 1996. Soil excavation was performed and the concentration of lead in the soil remaining at the site were below the site-specific target cleanup. goal of 320 mg/kg. In addition, lead was not detected in ground-water beneath the subject site.

Based on information in the above-referenced file and with the provision that the information provided to this agency was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action related to the lead contaminated soil is required.
