Progress Report No. 2. Initial removal of soil contaminated with diesel fuel and soil contaminated with lead.

Dear Mr. Schneider:

Ecology Recovery Associates was contracted to remove contaminated soil at the referenced location and to collect additional environmental samples from the bottom of the excavated areas. This letter summarizes progress to date

The dimensions and depth of the soil excavation were based on the sampling report by Berlogar Geotechnical Consultants (BGC) and specifically on the field sheet dated 8/11/97 by T.B.

### Lead Contamination

An area 15' x 15' x 0.5' was excavated in front of the welding shop. Approximately 5 cubic yards of soil was packaged for disposal at a California approved hazardous waste disposal facility. The soil will be shipped under CA Hazardous Waste Manifest 90472987 within the next ten days. Two samples were collected from a depth of 6 inches below the bottom of the excavation. These samples contained 17 and 8.3 mg/Kg total lead. BGC has collected additional confirmatory samples from the same area.

#### **Diesel Fuel Contamination**

An area inside the center room of the gas house and extending approximately 15 feet outside, to the east, was excavated. The entire area was excavated to a depth of one foot. The soil near the north wall was excavated as deep as 3.5 feet because discoloration and odor indicated that diesel fuel had penetrate at least to this depth. A total of 33.14 tons of soil were removed for disposal and shipped to TPS Technologies on 6/23/98 under Manifests numbers 00356-001 and 00356-002(Attached). A soil sample taken from the bottom of the excavation contained 3.2 mg/Kg diesel fuel. BGC has also collected additional samples from the bottom of this excavated area.

#### **Additional Work**

Sometime after the two contaminated areas had been excavated, we were advised that there might be additional hydrocarbon cantamination in room east of the workshop. Therefore BGC has collected soil samples from this area also. Depending upon the results from analysis of the three sets of samples collected by BGC, additional soil removal may be required. Should this be necessary, **ERA** will meet with your staff and BGC to develop an appropriate remediation plan.
