## Gentlemen:

We will remove the existing underground gasoline tank according to the following plan:

## I. Obtain Tank Closure Permits

- Alameda County Department of Environmental Health
- Emeryville Fire Department

#### II. Drain Tank

Martinez Industrial (Martinez, CA) will pump out any liquid in the tank. Our superintendent and one laborer will assist.

# III. Disconnect Tank Piping

a. On-site inspection reveals the tank piping can be removed with the tank.

## IV. Excavate and Shore, Remove Fence

- a. Excavated materials will be temporarily stockpiled on-site in drop boxes.
- b. Superintendent will observe excavated materials for discoloration and/or odor.
- c. Alameda County Department of Environmental Health will visually inspect site. They will invoice Underground Construction for inspection fees based on inspection hours on-site.

#### V. Remove Tank

- a. Tank will be rendered inert by filling with dry ice 15 lbs. of ice per 1000 gallons of tank capacity.
- b. Tank will be offhauled by Erickson, Inc. (Martinez, CA). Erickson will provide the hazardous waste manifest. Erickson will scrub, cut up the tank and send certificates of completion to Underground Construction.

#### VI. Test Soil

a. Brown and Caldwell (Pleasant Hill, CA) will take two soil samples from the excavation. The test results will be sent to Westinghouse for a determination of the next activity.

## VII. Backfill and Compact

a. Upon approval by Westinghouse the excavation will be backfilled.

## VIII. Resurface

a. Asphalt will be placed to conform to existing grade.
