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Environmental Database Summary Certifications

1. ASSESSMENT UPDATE SUMMARY

The following is a summary of Site Assessment Update findings prepared for Hardage Suite Hotels, Inc. in November and December of 1997. The assessment was completed in accordance with ASTM standard E-1527 and accepted industry standards.

This assessment was based on regulatory agency database list review, report review and a physical inspection of Property. The assessment was limited to (1) paved parcel of land located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Powell Street and Shellmound Street in Emeryville, California.

Evidence of hazardous materials used was not observed on the Property. However, evidence of disposal of potentially hazardous waste, including construction debris and 55-gallon drums, was observed on the Property.

Comparison of current regulatory agency site lists provided by ERIIS with the lists provided in a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment prepared by EMG dated June 22, 1995 revealed a total of 17 sites not previously listed. Eight of the sites are upgradient of the Property. However, none of the sites is believed to be likely of having impacted the Property.

Review of subsurface investigation reports by others shows that metals and petroleum hydrocarbons have been detected in soil at the site.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The Site Assessment included, but was not limited to, the following:

- a. A physical inspection of the subject Property and visual observation for evidence of hazardous material used and potential hazardous waste contamination.
- b. A review and comparison of agency listing to determine if new potential contaminant sources have been identified in the vicinity of the Property since 1995.
- c. Inquiry and communications with relevant agencies regarding availability of files for review of evidence of past hazardous materials use, contamination, or remediation on the subject site or properties within a one mile distance from the Property boundaries.
- d. Review of available reports documenting past investigations of historical property use and subsurface investigations at or near the site.

Hardage Suite Hotels, Inc. may rely upon the extent character and conclusions presented in this Environmental Site Assessment report. The client did not, in any way, limit this site assessment,

resulting report, or findings herein RGA is not, however, responsible for public records omissions at the local, state or federal levels.

REGULATORY AGENCY DATABASE REVIEW

Sites in the vicinity of the Property which were listed in an ERIIS ASTM Detail Radius Report dated November 20, 1997 were compared with government agency databases presented in the Phase I Environmental Site Assessment prepared by EMG dated June 22, 1995 for the Property. 3. SITE LOCATION

The subject Property is comprised of one parcel of land totaling approximately 2.01 acres in a mainly industrial or commercial area of Emeryville, California. The Property, Assessor's Parcel No. 11 on Tax Map 49, Block 1493 is roughly rectangular in shape and is located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Powell Street and Shellmound Street in Emeryville, California.

The adjacent site to the north is listed in local, state or federal agency registry of facilities with documented, active hazardous materials release episodes. However, based on all available information, RGA does not expect that the adjacent site and others in the area have had hazardous materials releases that are likely to significantly impact the subject Property

4. ENVIRONMENTAL SETTING

4.1 REGIONAL SOIL CLASSIFICATIONS

Based on review of regional geologic maps provided from U.S. Geological Survey Professional Paper 943, "Flatland Deposits - Their Geology and Engineering Properties and Their Importance to Comprehensive Planning," by E.J. Helley and K.R. Lajorie, 1979 the subject site is underlain by Holocene Bay Mud (QHBM). The Bay Mud is described as unconsolidated water-saturated dark plastic carbonaceous clay and silty clay. The site is in contact to the east with Fine-Grained Alluvium (Qhaf). The fine-grained alluvium is described as unconsolidated plastic moderately to poorly sorted carbonaceous silt and clay.

4.2 HYDROLOGY

Based on review of a 1992 Applied Geosystems Inc. report the site is underlain by fill. Groundwater is encountered at a depth of 1.8 to 5.0 feet. Groundwater flow direction is to the south or southwest.

4.3 TOPOGRAPHY

The subject Property is located on what is known as the San Francisco Bay in the San Francisco Bay area. The ground surface in the area slopes very gradually to the west and the Property elevation is approximately ten (10) feet above mean sea level.

4.4 RADON CONCENTRATIONS

The EPA's Office of Radiation and Indoor Air has predicted that the average indoor screening level of randon in the area is greater than 2.0 pico Curies per liter of air (pCi/L) but less than 4.0 pCi/L. The EPA has established that concentrations exceeding 4.0 pCi/L may be considered hazardous to the health of susceptible individuals.

5. SITE HISTORY

Reports were not available for review at the Regional Water Quality Control Board or the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health at the time that this Phase I Update was prepared. The following documents which were provided by HSHI were reviewed.

- a. "Review of Site Characterization Studies and Proposed Work Plan" dated May 18, 1990 by Tenera Environmental Services
- b. Alameda County Department of Environmental Health letter dated June 8, 1990 titled, "Proposed Remedial Actions to be Implemented at the ATDC Project at Shellmound and Powell Streets, Emeryville"
- c. "Supplemental Site Characterization Studies" dated July 5, 1990 by Tenera Environmental Services
- d. Alameda County Department of Environmental Health letter dated August 3, 1990 titled, "ATDC Project at Shellmound and Powell Streets, Emeryville"
- e. "Preliminary Site Assessment" dated May 22, 1990 by Applied Geosciences, Inc.
- f. "Phase II Subsurface Investigation" dated February 12, 1992 by Applied Geosciences, Inc.
- g. "Phase I Environmental Site Assessment" dated June 22, 1995 by EMG

- h. EMG letter dated March 25, 1996 titled, "Results of Groundwater Sampling"
- i. EMG letter dated April 12, 1996 titled, "Another Tree Development"

Each of these documents is briefly discussed below.

May 18, 1990 Tenera Environmental Services Report

Tenera Environmental Services (Tenera) met with the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) caseworker, Dennis Byrne, and the property owner, Another Tree Development Corporation (ATDC) on May 10, 1990 to discuss development of the site. In response to a request from the ACDEH, Tenera prepared the document titled, "Review of Site Characterization Studies and Proposed Work Plan" dated May 18, 1990. In the work plan, Tenera reviewed and summarized reports by others which discussed the history of development and use of the Property. Tenera concluded that the nature and locations of existing and potential sources of soil and groundwater contamination on the site have been adequately identified through prior site investigations. Tenera provided three recommendations as follows.

- a. ACDEH approve excavation and disposal of a localized area of elevated metal concentrations which exceeded the applicable TTLC values.
- b. ACDEH grant approval to leave asphalt-like waste material in place and to cap the area where the asphalt-like material was present with building foundations, paving, or similar materials.
- c. Complete a focused groundwater investigation in conjunction with development of the site.

 The investigation would include the installation and sampling of groundwater monitoring wells.

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health Letter Dated June 8, 1990

The ACDEH responded to the Tenera work plan in a letter dated June 8, 1990 titled, "Proposed Remedial Actions to be Implemented at the ATDC Project at Shellmound and Powell Streets, Emeryville." In the letter, the ACDEH granted approval for excavation of the localized area of soil and for the groundwater monitoring well sites suggested in the work plan. The ACDEH also requested that the nature and extent of the asphalt-like material identified beneath a portion of the Property be characterized.

July 5, 1990 Tenera Environmental Services Report

Tenera responded to the ACDEH request for additional information with a report titled, "Supplemental Site Characterization Studies," dated July 5, 1990. In the report, Tenera identified the extent of the asphalt-like material and stated that the material was not hazardous.

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health Letter Dated August 3, 1990

The ACDEH responded to the Tenera July 5, 1990 report with a letter dated August 3, 1990 titled, "ATDC Project at Shellmound and Powell Streets, Emeryville." In the letter, the ACDEH concurred with the assessment of the oily soil underlying a portion of the property as not constituting hazardous waste, and that excavation of this material would not be required. The ACDEH cautioned that further characterization of the material would be required if evidence were to arise that the data utilized in the classification of the material was not representative. The ACDEH also requested reevaluation of the groundwater monitoring well locations proposed in the work plan to ensure that a well be located downgradient of the asphalt-like material. The ACDEH stated that investigating the quality of groundwater need not hinder the development of the site, and that the ACDEH had no objection to development of the site once provided communication of a reasonable schedule as to when the groundwater investigation would begin. May 22, 1990 Applied Geosciences, Inc. Report

A Preliminary Site Assessment dated May 22, 1990 by Applied Geosciences, Inc. (AGI) discussed previous site investigations, previous property use, and potential sources of the asphalt-like material and elevated metals concentrations at the Property discussed previously by Tenera. The report contained six recommendations, including assessment of groundwater quality at the site and periodic review of reports of hazardous waste sites in the vicinity of the Property to assess the potential impact to the Property.

February 12, 1992 Applied Geosciences, Inc. Report

The results of subsurface investigation which included installation of soil borings and groundwater monitoring wells and analysis of soil and groundwater samples are presented in this report. The report included as appendices the Tenera reports referenced above, the ACDEH responses to the Tenera reports referenced above, and the AGI May 22, 1990 Preliminary Site Assessment referenced above. The report presented findings and recommendations which included the following.

- a. The concentrations of metals and/or petroleum products detected during the investigation might warrant classification of the subsurface soil as hazardous.
- b. The findings of the investigation should be reviewed with the ACDEH caseworker to determine the applicability of the previous approvals for site development by the ACDEH.
- c. Groundwater had been determined to flow to the west and/or southwest.
- d. The laboratory results of on-site groundwater monitoring wells indicate that surrounding properties which are reported on regulatory agency databases have not significantly impacted the Property.

June 22, 1995 EMG Report

A Phase I Environmental Site Assessment dated June 22, 1995 by EMG discussed previous property uses and identified the presence of two groundwater monitoring wells at the site. The EMG report identified the most recent investigation of the Property as being documented in a report by AGI dated February 12, 1992, and stated that the County's comments on the 1992 investigation were not provided or available. The EMG report provided several recommendations, including that the wells be sampled.

EMG Letters Dated March 25, 1996 and April 12, 1996

The March 25, 1996 letter transmitted the results of groundwater samples collected from two groundwater monitoring wells at the Property. The sample results showed that petroleum hydrocarbons were not detected, and that metals were not detected at concentrations exceeding their respective Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs).

The April 12, 1996 letter transmitted additional information related to the following.

- a. The rationale for the types of analyses for the groundwater samples.
- b. Clarification of the potential impact of potential upgradient offsite contaminant sources to the Property.
- c. Categorization of the impacted soil at the site as not being hazardous.
- d. The ACDEH will not likely require remedial activities or investigations or prohibit development of the property.

6. SITE DESCRIPTION AND INSPECTION

The Property was visually inspected on December 2, 1997. The site consists of a paved parking lot which is presently used by visitors to the adjacent Emery Bay Marketplace to the North of the Property. Portions of the parking lot are landscaped.

A total of four groundwater monitoring well boxes and one broken groundwater monitoring well box were observed at the Property. Two of the groundwater monitoring wells had been sampled by RGA in November 1997. The broken well box was filled with compacted dirt and the top of a four-inch diameter well cap was visible in the center of the well box.

No evidence of hazardous material use was observed. However, evidence of dumping of debris and various containers which could potentially contain hazardous waste was observed. The size of the debris piles ranged from pick up truck load to dump truck load in size. A list of the observed contents of each of the various debris piles and the types of containers is presented below.

- a. Seven full 55-gallon drums (17H type) on the southern Property border with the following label "Pending Analysis/Geomatrix Consultants/100 Pine Street, 10th Floor/ San Francisco, CA, 94111/415-434-9400.
- b. One full 55-gallon drum (17H type) on the southern Property border which was used to receive groundwater monitoring well purge water associated with RGA well sampling activities in November, 1997.
- c. Asphalt and dirt.
- d. Twigs and leaves.
- e. Railroad ties.
- f. Broken pallets, wood scraps and two 5-gallon plastic buckets.
- g. Railroad ties and concrete.
- h. One partially full plastic 5-gallon bucket labeled "SS 1-H Asphalt Emulsion."
- i. One full 55-gallon drum (17H type) at the central portion of the Property. The drum is unlabeled, and fresh black staining of what appears to be oil was observed on the sides and at the asphalt at the base of the drum.
- j. Broken doors, empty paint cans (one-gallon and spray can containers).
- k. Gravel.
- 1. Dirt, rock and concrete (an estimated two dump truck loads) and one metal 5-gallon paint bucket.
- m. Concrete, rock, wood scraps, cardboard boxes, empty one-quart oil bottles, empty spray paint containers, asphalt.
- n. One partially full 55-gallon drum (17E type) at the central portion of the Property. The drum is labeled "Glyclean Recycled Anti Freeze."
- o. Two partially full unlabeled metal 5-gallon cans and one almost full uncapped metal 5-gallon can labeled, "10% Copper Napthanate."

7. REGULATORY AGENCY REVIEW

Files of the following federal, state and local agencies and databases were researched for potential environmental contamination sources concerning the subject property. Each available file pertaining to the subject Property and sites within a mile distance of the Property line were reviewed.

8. <u>DISCUSSION</u>

The ERIIS ASTM Detail Radius Report dated November 20, 1997 identified the Days Inn as being located 0.02 miles to the northwest of the property. However, this site is located to the southwest of the Property.

Groundwater flow direction at the site was reported to be to the south or southwest. Sites located to the north or northeast of the property are considered to be upgradient of the site. A total of three sites not identified in the EMG 1995 report were identified upgradient of the site within 0.25 miles of the Property. An additional four sites were identified between 0.44 and 0.48 miles upgradient of the Property, and one site was identified 0.74 miles upgradient of the Property. The only sites identified as leaking underground storage tank sites were the four sites located between 0.44 and 0.48 miles from the Property. The distance of these sites from the Property make it unlikely that these sites may have impacted the Property.

9. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Based upon the findings of this Phase I Update, RGA has the following recommendations.

- a. Secure the property boundary to prevent the additional accumulation of any other potentially hazardous waste.
- b. Containerize and remove any hazardous waste which is present at the Property which could impact the Property.
- c. Submit a work plan to the ACDEH for monitoring and sampling of the existing groundwater monitoring wells, and the addition of any groundwater monitoring wells, as necessary, to satisfy the request set forth in the August 3, 1990 ACDEH letter for a groundwater monitoring well downgradient of the asphalt-like material.

10. LIMITATIONS

The reader should be aware that the strict interpretation of the Federal Comprehensive Emergency Response and Compensation Liability Act (CERCLA) and State of California legislation and case law may hold the landowner responsible for liability including future cleanup costs. This statement is not motivated by any condition of the subject property but as a general statement of the advisability that property owners and purchasers exercise all appropriate precautions regarding hazardous materials risks.

This report does not provide the level of detail to be utilized for structural demolition or remodeling, or soil or groundwater remediation. The conclusions presented in this report are professional opinions based on the data described in this report. They are intended only for the site, and apply to conditions existing at the time of our study. Changes in applicable standards can also occur as the result of legislation or from broadening knowledge. Accordingly, the findings of this report may be invalidated, wholly or in part, by changes beyond our control. Analyses are based upon available information. RGA is not responsible for public database or record omissions.


