During the four quarters of monitoring, oil was reported in two of the three wells during the first quarter of sampling; the reported levels of oil were 0.3 mg/l, barely above the detection limit of 0.2 mg/l. No other hazardous constituents have been detected in any of the wells during any of the sampling events. We believe that the three quarters of no detection following a detection barely above the detection limit is sufficient to establish non-degradation of groundwater in the vicinity of the wells.

We believe that this letter responds to questions raised in your 30 December 1991 letter, and we look forward to receiving a copy of your letter to the RWQCB recommending site closure. Please contact me if you have any additional questions about the information presented herein.
