Mr. Miles stated that no other tanks, other than the waste oil tank, were located beneath the former Taco Ball building. Mr. Miles stated that the waste oil tank only had a capacity of 255 gallons. Mr. Shin requested a copy of the waste oil tank manifest.

According to Mr. Miles, all the sidewall excavation samples were collected from the capillary fringe. Mr. Shin requested that Mr. Miles transpire the area of excavation over a figure showing details of sampling locations at the site. Mr. Miles stated that the MW's have already been installed! (Even though the locations for these wells had not yet been approved by the County). (Note: Also the County was not

informed when the waste oil tank was discovered and removed!

Temporary wells were already installed and removed at the site. The purpose of these wells was to collect the groundwater samples that were a part of the initial soil sampling at the site. Permanent wells will definitely be installed at the site.

Mike Mitra stated that he would submit tentative plans proposing the monitoring well locations & design to Alameda County.

Mike Mitra agreed to survey the installed wells to established benchmarks to 0.01 foot.

Mike Mitra stated that Taco Bell will indeed proceed w/ the soil excavation and sampling plans discussed at the meeting based on the weather. It was predicted by LRA Environmental that this might be done in <sup>about</sup> May 1st.
