Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Responsible Party Identification

Existence of Unauthorized Release

In January 2005, eight soil borings were advanced in the vicinity of the underground storage tanks (USTs) and dispensers as part of a due diligence investigation. MTBE and TBA were detected in four soil samples collected from the borings at maximum concentrations of 0.022 ppm of MTBE and 0.031 ppm of TBA. Four monitoring wells were installed at the site in November 2008. Groundwater samples collected from the monitoring wells contained total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg) at concentrations up to 28,000 ppb. Based on the site characterization data, an unauthorized release or releases occurred from the UST system.

Responsible Party Identification

Atlantic Richfield Company is a responsible party for the fuel leak because they were the business owner, tank owner, and tank operator at the time of the unauthorized release (Definition 1), were the property owner at the time of the unauthorized release (Definition 3), and had control of the UST at the time of or following an unauthorized release (Definition 4).

Choonghun Chun purchased the property in May 2005. As the current owner of the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3), Choonghun Chun is also a responsible party.
