Hi Barbara, we did not include asphalt in the boring log as it was likely only in the surface soil which was collected in the sample, and we could not open the acetate sleeve to inspect the surface soil sample due to the need to analyze the sample for VOCs. We indicated in section 6.3 of the Soil and Groundwater Investigation Report that the elevated concentrations of diesel and motor oil detected in the surface soil sample collected in the area of the former AST was likely caused by fragments of asphalt in the sample as we did not observe any staining or odors in the shallow soil. If the impacts were caused by a release from the former AST, there should have been some staining or odors in the shallow soil given the very high concentrations of diesel and motor oil detected. Please let me know if you have any further questions regarding the report. Thanks

About the landowner notification, I'll send you that when the site gets close to closure.

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

