Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance"

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Responsible Party Identification

Existence of Unauthorized Release

Three underground storage tanks (USTs) were located under the sidewalk in front of 316 38th Street in Oakland, CA. In November, 2008, the USTs were decommissioned by filling the USTs with a slurry cement mixture. Soil and groundwater samples were collected from soil borings advanced in the vicinity of each UST. Elevated PID readings and hydrocarbon staining were observed in 5 of the 7 soil borings advanced in the area of the USTs. Total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline were detected in soil samples collected from the soil borings at concentrations up to 4,100 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg). Total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline and benzene were detected in grab groundwater samples at concentrations up to 28,000 and 22 micrograms per liter, respectively. Based on observations from the UST decommissioning and soil and groundwater sampling conducted in the area of the USTs, an unauthorized release occurred from the USTs.

Responsible Party Identification

Earl Thompson, Sr. was the business owner, tank owner, and tank operator at the time of the unauthorized release (Definition 1) and had control of the UST at the time of or following an unauthorized release (Definition 4). The Estate of Earl Thompson, Sr. is the current owner of the site and is a responsible party because they are the current owner of a property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).
