John returned VM @ 1:30 – we spoke of 45 ft depth, that it would be very unusual to go that deep, a Chevron / Valero site just around the corner has gw at <10 ft, but in bedrock, and in places likely bedrock at 0.5 ft with water in subgrade (surface or ground water?). Our consensus is that this is a safety measure for consultant, but is an unknown he'd need to flesh out with them.

We also spoke about the USTCF, very limited funds these days. Had a question in regards to needing to apply first, before contract, or can they apply afterwards? I don't recall, probably best to call fund to ask those specifics. He indicates he will.
