Clipper Exxpress Company meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because it owned or operated an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1) and had control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

Catellus Development Corporation (Catellus) was the owner of the property at the time the leaks were discovered. Catellus meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).

Emeryville Retail Properties, LP acquired the parcel formerly occupied by Clipper from Catellus on September 26, 1997. Emeryville Retail Properties, LP meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).

Catellus merged with ProLogis Logistics Services and became the property owner on January 18, 2011. ProLogis Logistics Services meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).
