This letter confirms the completion of the removal of one underground storage tank (UST) at the above subject site; which had a capacity of 425 gallons and was determined to contain diesel and bunker oil-range fuel. P & D Environmental, Inc. performed and completed the UST removal. The project began on 9/14/2012 and was completed on 9/20/12.

The City Of Oakland Fire Department/Hazardous Material Management Program (OFD/HMMP) staff has received a copy of the analytical results. Based on the available information and with the provision that the information provided to OFD/HMMP was accurate and representative of site conditions, no further action related to the UST removed at the above location is required at this time by this office. The soil sampling results for sample taken in the pit below the tank were well below the environmental screening levels (ESL(s)) for the site.
