The following information is provided:

- (a) The site owner and Responsible Party is Najmeddin Ravan.
- (b) The Voluntary Remedial Action Agreement will apply to 1400 Powell Street, Emeryville.
- (c) ACDEH previously provided regulatory oversight of a leaking underground storage tank (LUST) case at this site. The LUST case was closed in May 2014 with site management requirements due to residual contamination. The purpose of the Remedial Action Agreement will be to review current site conditions and a proposed change in land use.
