Dear Bradley and Sandra Hirst and Paul and Alice Sun:

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) staff has reviewed the case file for the above referenced fuel leak case, including the report entitled "Supplemental Site Investigation Work Plan," dated April 6, 2016. The Work Plan, which was prepared on your behalf by Environmental Risk Assessors, proposes the following: two borings, one on the western part of the site and the other on the southern adjacent parcel, to collect soil and groundwater samples to be analyzed for total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline, diesel, and Stoddard solvent as well as volatile organic compounds (VOCs) and metals; and two soil gas samples at the site to be analyzed for VOCs. The proposed borings for soil and groundwater sampling appear to attempt to identify off-site sources of contamination rather than on-site sources.

So this case can move forward, ACDEH staff requests a meeting at our office with the consultant and Responsible Parties to further discuss a work plan strategy where on-site sources of the leak are delineated. We have the following dates and time frames available for the meeting:

Wednesday, June 8, 2016, between 1 and 5 pm Tuesday, June 14, between 9 am and 10:30 am Tuesday, June 21, between 9 am and 12 pm
