Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

Existence of Unauthorized Release

Two 10,000-gallon underground storage tanks (USTs), used for the storage of gasoline fuel, and associated product lines were excavated and removed from the site on June 18, 1998. A gasoline odor and visible discoloration of soil was noted in the UST pit at the time of removal. Maximum petroleum hydrocarbon concentrations of 1,100 milligrams per kilogram (mg/Kg) total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPH-g), 5.2 mg/Kg benzene, and 13 mg/Kg methyl tertiary butyl ether (MTBE) were detected in initial soil samples collected from beneath the USTs. Additionally, groundwater concentrations reported in well MW-5, an adjacent downgradient monitoring well associated with ACEH case #RO0000271, GeoTracker Global ID T0600100538, sampled on July 15, 2015, were reported to contain 8,800 micrograms per liter (ug/L) TPHg, 2,200 ug/L benzene, 850 ug/L MTBE and 6,700 ug/L tertiary butyl alcohol (TBA). These concentrations indicate an unauthorized release has occurred from the underground storage tank system at this site.

Responsible Party Identification

The Frederick D and Geraldine G Emory Trust acquired title of the property on June 26, 1992. The Frederick D and Geraldine G Emory Trust meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because it owns the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).

Quik Stop Markets, Inc. meets the definition of a responsible party for the site because it owns or operates underground storage tanks used for the storage of any hazardous substance (Definition 1) and had control over underground storage tanks at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).
