Hi Keith

PG&E asked me to meet them at the property today to discuss the borings on the western portion of the site (SB-5 and SB-6) as there is a PG&E pipeline along the western border (in railroad right of way) and borings cannot be closer than 10 feet. Pipeline location is marked with pink flag between fence and tree in background of photo.

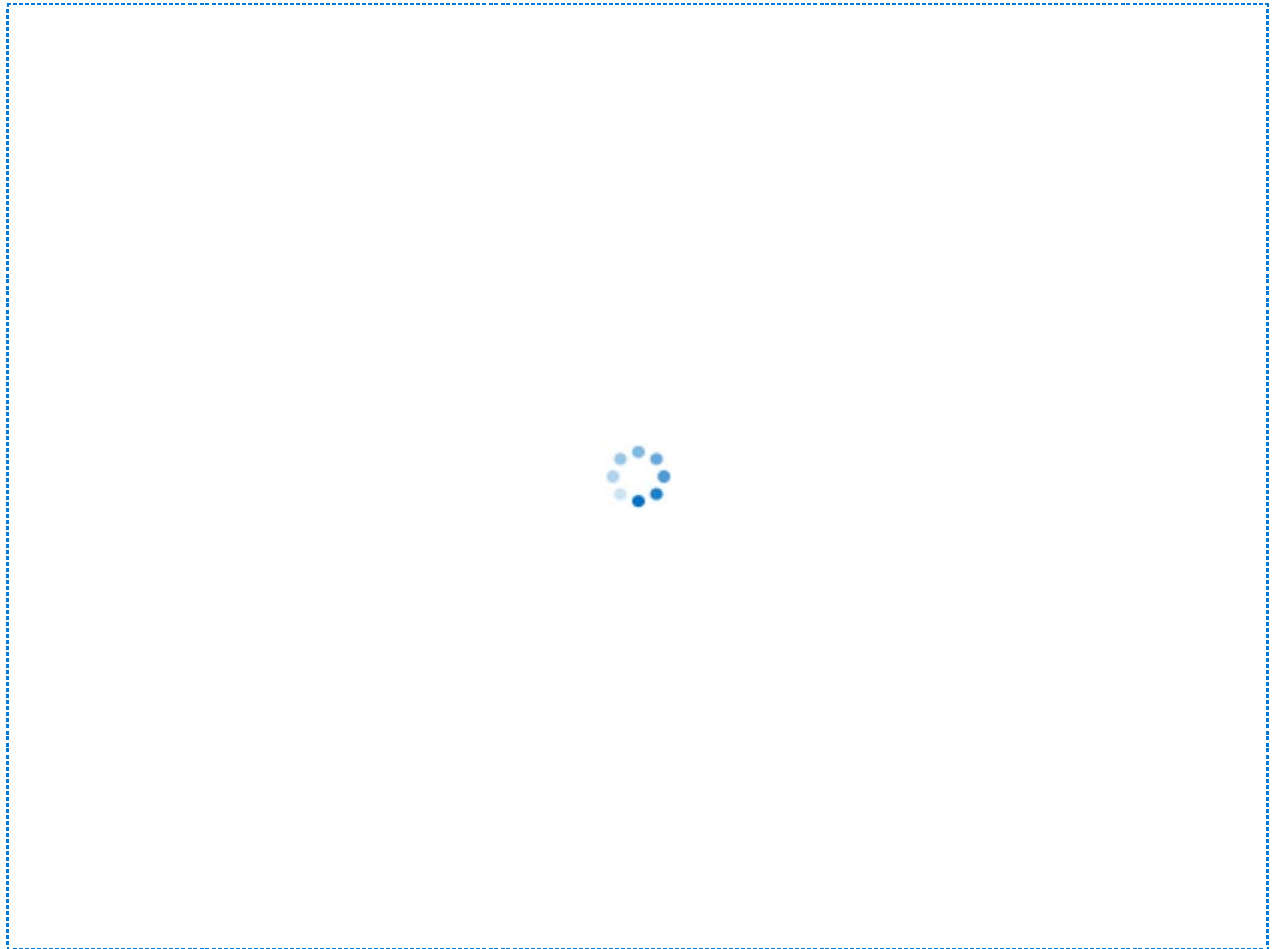
SB-6 was more than 10 feet from the pipeline so it can remain where planned. SB-5 was planned at the southwestern corner of the paint storage shed (downgradient side; location marked in white paint in the leaves - near fence) but needs to be moved about 5 feet to the east near the southeastern corner of the paint storage shed (at white circle with x - on pavement). Former boring SB-4 is about 5 feet to the northeast of new SB-5 location. Hydrocarbons and some VOCs were reported in groundwater samples from boring SB-4.

We will plan to drill SB-5 at new location on Tuesday unless we hear otherwise from you.
