Existence of Unauthorized Release

A phase I report dated July 9, 2015 indicates that between approximately 1930 and 1975, an auto repair garage with a gas and oil fueling area operated on the property (parcel number 32-2031-126). On November 6, 2015, two 750 gallon underground storage tanks (USTs) were excavated 3 feet below the tanks to 11 feet below ground surface (bgs), and the tanks removed. Soil samples were collected at 11 feet bgs. A maximum petroleum hydrocarbon concentration of 200 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPH-g) was detected in the bottom samples. This concentration indicates that an unauthorized release has occurred from the underground storage tank at this site.
