Per our email notification dated March 6, 2018, Wheeler Group Environmental LLC conducted sub-slab vapor sampling at the subject residence on Friday, 3/9/18. We received a preliminary data report from Torrent Lab on 3/15/18, presenting the TO-15 VOC results (only) for the two sub-slab vapor samples collected at the Site; the diesel-range organics by TO-17 were not available at this time due to instrumentation problems. Per this morning's email correspondence with Torrent, the instrumentation used for TO-17 analysis is still not functioning, with repairs not anticipated until next week.

On behalf of Marcia Redford, due to unavailable lab data, we will not be able to complete our Data Gap Investigation Report for the subject property by the revised deadline of 3/23/18, and we request an additional 2-week extension for submittal of the report until April 6, 2018.
