#### Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Department of Environmental Health (ACDEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party four ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

#### **Existence of Unauthorized Release**

A subsurface investigation was conducted in June 2017 and soil and groundwater samples were collected. Soil contamination up to 360 milligrams per kilogram (mg/kg) Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH) as motor oil (TPHmo) and up to 27 mg/kg TPH as diesel (TPHd) were detected. In groundwater concentrations up to 300 micrograms per liter ( $\mu$ /l) TPH as gasoline (TPHg), 220  $\mu$ /l TPHmo were detected. These data indicate that an unauthorized release has occurred at the site.

### **Responsible Party Identification**

Gail and Heath Angelo Jr, and Richard B and Alice Miles, and H & RK & G Block purchased the property by September 1973. Collectively, they are a responsible party for the site because they formerly owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).

Gail and Heath Angelo Jr, and Richard B and Alice Miles (trustees), received or purchased the property by February 1997. Collectively, they are a responsible party for the site because they formerly owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).

Barbara and Dominic Devincenzi purchased the property by August 2000. They are a responsible party for the site because they formerly owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).

Standard Oil Company was issued a permit to reconstruct a service station, replacing an existing service station, from the City of Oakland Building Department in 1937, was permitted to reconstruct the service station building on the property in 1962, maintained the building and sought additional permits from the City of Oakland Building Department until a permit from the City of Oakland Building Department was issued to wreck and clear the site in 1973. Standard Oil, and Chevron through mergers and acquisitions, is a responsible party for the site because it owned or operated an underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use (Definition 2), and it had control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

4336 Broadway LLC purchased the property by October 2017. They are a responsible party for the site because they formerly owned the property where an unauthorized release occurred (Definition 3).
