Please include the proposed locations of additional soil bores associated with your investigation along with a brief description of the proposed work. ACDEH requests the figure be prepared using a photographic base showing the site and nearby features to aid in our determination of the proximity of the well locations to our cases.

Additionally, ACDEH requests the contact information, including email address(es), of both client and Port of Oakland personnel associated with this project, should further project discussion be warranted.
