Potential For Additional Responsible Parties (RPs)
For Subsurface Contamination

Dear Mr. Hiendl:

On February 8, 1993, we discussed the possibility for subsurface contamination at the Ingersoll-Rand (IR) San Leandro maintenance facility resulting partially, or wholly, from contributions from additional responsible parties (RPs). The steps to a methodical approach as outlined in our discussion are recounted below.

- 1) Database Search of Government Environmental Records In this step, specific government records would be searched electronically using computerized procedures. Thus, searches within numerous databases can be rapidly conducted to provide precursory information about any location listed by government agencies. Of the steps in this approach, this is the least expensive.
- 2) Detailed Records Search of Public Environmental Records In this step, public documents held at various government agencies would be examined to provide detailed information about pertinent sites identified in step one.
- 3) Collection of groundwater and/or soil samples at strategic locations This step would be conducted if information gathered in the two previous steps suggest it is warranted. It would involve collection and analysis of samples from areas within IR property where gasoline contamination from off-site sources is suspected. Of the three steps, this is the most expensive.

Pursuit to your request, IT Corporation (IT) proceeded with the first step in the outlined approach, which is the database search of government records.

The database search of government records was ordered from Vista Environmental Information, Inc (Vista). Vista was selected for this task because they are independent of IT and have a special pricing agreement with us. On behalf of IR, IT requested that the Vista search all eleven available government databases for Vista search all eleven available government databases are listed below with a brief description:

A. CERCLIS: Contaminated Site Under Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) of 1980.

B. NPL: National Priority List - Consists of CERCLIS sites which present the greatest risk to human health and the environment are added to the NPL.

Federal Superfund Liens - Under CERCLA the Federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has authority to file liens against real property to recover clean up, response, and any other expenditure made by EPA under the CERCLA program.

D. CORTESE: Hazardous Waste And Substance Sites List The California Governor's Office of Planning
and Research annually publishes a listing of
potential and confirmed hazardous waste sites
throughout the State of California.

E. CAL-Sites

(AWP): The Annual Work Plan (AWP) contains a listing of all verified hazardous waste site that are or will be targeted for abatement by the California Environmental Protection Agency.

facility. Substantial pre-existing evidence that Aervoe does not likely provide a contributory source of gasoline contamination is the lack of dissolved phase gasoline in the expected pathway fugitive gasoline would follow toward the maintenance facility. The monitoring well MW-02, soil boring CC-05, and temporary well points TW-02 and TW-03 installed at the maintenance facility would all be expected to contain higher levels of dissolved gasoline than they do if an off-site source from the location of Aervoe Pacific was contributing to the IR contamination problem (Attachment C).

2) Lucky Distribution Center 1701 Marina Boulevard San Leandro, CA Vista Site No. 35

Mormal Site Visit

As a distribution center, trucks receive and distribute goods for area Lucky stores. The trucks are predominately 18 wheel vehicles which operate on diesel fuel. Monitoring wells, most likely for groundwater, were observed. No confirmatory observations were made with respect to remedial activities.

Additional Notes

It is unlikely that the release of Lucky Distribution Center impacted the IR maintenance facility because interpretations of the observations made suggests the material released into the subsurface is diesel. The monitoring wells indicate a response to a release, but it should be acknowledged that if the LUST release had migrated off-site Lucky would have to make an effort to capture the fugitive petroleum and would be required to notify the owners/operators of nearby properties that are affected. Since IR has not been notified about this type of matter, fugitive petroleum released at the Lucky site has either remained on site or migrated in a direction other than toward IR.

3) Middleton Welders Supply 1717 Timothy Drive San Leandro, CA. Vista Site No. 46

Informal Site Visit

Although no signs of underground and no above ground tanks were visible, this location appears to be a distribution center with at least one delivery truck. No monitoring wells or remediation activities were observed.

Additional Notes

The delivery truck reported in the informal site visit, appeared to have a diesel engine. This could suggest that the leak from the UST at this site may have been diesel. Without any historical knowledge of this site, it is difficult to be certain about this conclusion. Although this site is nearly directly up gradient from the IR property it is about three-quarters of a mile away. Three-quarters of a mile migration distance is fairly great in the fine sediments of the region. If the release did migrate this distance to impact the IR property well MW-01 and soil boring CC-01 would register detectable concentrations of gasoline contaminants, but as it is they do not (Attachment C).


Informal Site Visit

One above ground diesel tank was visible. No monitoring wells were visible. Several delivery trucks were reported.

Additional Notes

The above ground diesel tank appeared to be new, suggesting the LUST listing resulted from a release from a diesel UST. The trucks delivering goods and the age of the building suggest diesel fuel has been stored on site longer than the age of the new tank. Laboratory testing of soil, soil vapor, and water samples recovered from the IR property have not ever shown impact from diesel contamination.

Under Section 107(L) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA) 42 U.S.C. Section 9607 (1), US EPA has authority to file liens against real property to recover clean up, response, and any other expenditure made by US EPA under the CERCLA program. US EPA has prepared a listing of filed notices of Superfund liens which is updated quarterly. Because these liens are "statutory liens," they arise when the agency spends money on a site or when notification of potential liability is received by the owner of the property. EPA maintains that these liens can arise without filing, however, and they suggest checking CERCLIS sites for lien status.

### HAZARDOUS WASTE AND SUBSTANCES SITES LIST CORTESE

The information presented in this report is updated to November, 1990.

The California Governor's Office of Planning and Research annually publishes a listing of potential and confirmed hazardous waste sites throughout the State of California under Government Code Section 65962.5. This list is based on input from the following agencies:

- 1) DHS1: Records that have been compiled by the Toxic Substances Control Division of the Department of Health Services. This code indicates abandoned hazardous waste sites.
- DHS2: Records that have been compiled by the Environmental Health Division of the Department of Health Services. This code indicates conteminated public water drinking wells that serve less than 200 connections ("small wells").
- 3) DHS3: Records that have been compiled by the Environmental Health Division of the Department of Health Services and consist of conteminated public water drinking wells that serve more than 200 connections ("large wells").

The information presented in this report is updated to October 31, 1991.

The Annual Work Plan (AWP) contains a listing of all verified hazardous waste sites that are or will be targeted for abatement by the California Environmental Protection Agency under the Hazardous Substance Cleanup Bond Act of 1984 (Health and Safety Code Section 25356) and the Hazardous Substance Account (HSA). Hazardous waste sites may be discovered by the department directly or referred to the department for confirmation and follow up action by another government agency, such as a local health department, a Regional Water Quality Control Board, a responsible party or a concerned citizen. New sites are added to this database as they are verified and the "Preliminary Assessment, Site Investigation and Hazard Ranking System" processes are completed. This database is updated once annually after approval of the California state legislature and has been incorporated into the CAL-SITES database.

This database currently contains a list of approximately 450 sites in the State of California.

# FACTOR AVENUE PLUME (NO. 1465), SAN LEANDRO

#### Site Information

Location and Type of Site 1465 Factor Avenue San Leandro, CA 94577 Alameda

The Factor Avenue site is a contaminated shallow aquifer.

### Description of Hazardous Wastes

Chemicals found on the site include: cyanide at 120 parts per billion (ppb); 1-1-Dichloroethylene (DCE) at 524 ppb; and 1,1- and 1,2-Dichloroethane (DCA) at 7.4 and 4.8 ppb, respectively; trans 1-2-dichloroethylene at 2110 ppb; 1-1-trichloroethane at 321 ppb; trichloroethylene (TCE) at 2215 ppb; tetrachloroethylene (PCE) at 263 ppb; benzene at 7.19 pp); and toluene at 2.0 ppb.

### Threat to Public Health and Environment

Ground water is a pathway for contaminant migration. Numerous private wells present possible route of exposure to humans. Residents of San Leandro who have shallow saels on their property are potential receptors for the tree to contaminants in ground water. The residents of record owning wells have been advised of possible exposures, in the event affected wells are used for drinking water.

#### Site Status

#### Status of Site Activity

The site is currently undergoing Phase II remedial investigation. Monitoring wells and stratigraphic borings will be installed. Following the Phase II work, DHS will prepare an initial endangerment assessment. East Bay MUD (EBMUD) has required the installation of back flow devices on all residences situated on parcels with water wells, whether or not the water is used for drinking.

#### Projected Revenue Sources

Bond funds will be used to investigate and possibly remediate the site. DHS has elected to continue the hazardous waste investigation, in the vicinity of 1465 Factor Avenue, San Leandro, even though multiple PRPs may be present. Following the collection of definitive information concerning responsibility, DHS will pursue enforcement actions, recover its costs, and require the responsible parties to implement the RAP.

This site has not been identified as an NPL site, nor does it appear to be a likely NPL candidate in the future. Therefore, it appears unlikely that federal funds are a viable source of revenue for this site.

#### Project Budget and Cash Flow Estimates

The cost estimates shown below reflect only State costs for site cleanup. All activities will be funded from Bond sale proceeds to the extent that federal Superfund or responsible party funding is not available.

THE DEGREE OF HEALTH HAZARD POSED BY CHEMICAL CONTAMINATION OF A SITE DEPENDS ON THE CONCENTRATION OF THE MATERIAL PRESENT AND THE DURATION OF EXPOSURE. DRS POLICY IS TO EVALUATE ALL LISTED HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE RELEASE SITES FOR THE NEED TO TAKE ACTION TO ARATE ANY ACUTE FUBLIC REALTH OR ENVIRONMENTAL THREATS POSED BY A SITE. THEREFORE, THE THREATS DESCRIBED IN THIS DOCUMENT GENERALLY REPRESENT THE FOTENTIAL IMPACT OF LONG-TERM EXPOSURE TO SPECIFIC HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES IF: 1) THE SITE IS NOT ARATED, 2) THE SUBSTANCES MIGRATE OFFSITE, AND 3) THE SUBSTANCES AT SOME POINT COME INTO CONTACT WITH HUMAN OR ENVIRONMENTAL RECEPTORS.

# BORDER ZONE PROPERTY ACT SITES (DEED RESTRICTIONS)

The information provided in this report is updated to February 1, 1992.

In accordance with Assembly Bill 816, and the Hazardous Waste Property/Border Zone Property Law (Health & Safety Code 25220), the CAL-EPA, Toxic Substances Control Program (TSCP) enters into voluntary deed restriction agreements with owners of property who propose building residences, schools, hopitals or day care centers on property that is "on or within 2,000 feet of a significant disposal of hazardous waste". Restrictions may include "activities on, over, or under the land, including, but not limited to, a prohibition against building, filling, grading, excavating, or mining" without the written permission of the TSCP.

This bill requires the TSCP to "notify the planning and building department of each city, county, or regional council of governments when a land use restriction has been recorded, and would require the planning and building department to enforce the restriction," although the TSCP has compiled a list of properties subject to environmental deed restrictions which is used to notify various building and planning departments in local jurisdictions.

### CAL-SITES (ASPIS)

The information presented in this report is updated to October 31, 1991.

Developed under Section 25359.6 of the Health and Safety Code, the California EPA Toxic Substance Control Program (TSCP) maintains a listing of potential and known hazardous waste sites. TSCP staff have interviewed officials from county health agencies, local fire departments, county agricultural commissioners, and other local agencies that could reasonably be expected to have information regarding potential waste sites. The Regional Water Quality Control Boards, Department of Fish and Game and other state environmental regulatory agencies' TSCP staffs also review historical land use data sources to generate lists of potentially contaminated sites.

This database was formerly known as the Abandoned Site Program Information System, but was integrated into the CAL-SITES database in 1991. Information concerning most of these sites should be considered preliminary although most confirmed sites from this database are merged into the AWP once they have been hazard ranked. This database currently contains more than 26,000 sites in the State of California.

The California Department of Health Services, Toxic Substances Control Division, has developed and maintained lists of hazardous waste generators and hazardous waste treatment storage and disposal facilities in the State of California, pursuant to the Hazardous Waste Control Law (Health and Safety Code Section 25100 et seq.), and the Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1976 (Health and Safety Code Section 25179.1 et seq). In addition, this law requires all counties to prepare and submit hazardous waste management plans. To assist the counties, the Toxic Substances Control Division maintains lists containing generation and disposal data within each county. This information has been assembled by the Toxic Substances Control Division from manifest reports required from hazardous waste generators. This database currently lists over 50,000 sites in the state of California.

Although the data reported here represents sites where at least one leak is known to have occurred, it is not uncommon for more than one tank to have leaked at a given site or cleanup case. The total number of cases reported statewide is over 5,900.






Proj. No. 141640 Piping and Scimpling Point Locations **~ 4535 #** 4557 SHED Building \*4557 SHED




