We are working on behalf of Mr. David Watson, the current owner of the former Vend Mart UST Site located at 1035 7<sup>th</sup> Street in Oakland (Alameda County Case No. RO0000036, RWQCB Case No. 01-1778). Mr. Watson has received letters from Alameda County requesting abandonment of site well MW-1. Gribi Associates has conducted a visit of the site and was unable to visually locate the well. It is likely that the well is located in a new landscaped area of the property and is now buried. Gribi Associates previously sampled the well approximately 10 years ago, and at the time we documented the that it was a 2-inch diameter well with a total depth of approximately 27.4 feet. Given the well's proximity to San Francisco Bay, I don't believe it would be in an area considered have beneficial groundwater use.

I have attached the following for your reference:

- Gribi Associate site figure: 1) Site Vicinity Map; and 2) Site Plan showing the approximate well location within the landscaped area in question
- Two figures based on survey data that were created for the re-construction of Interstate 880 following the 1989 earthquake.
  - $\circ$  The scales for the figures are approximately 1" = 40 feet for the Geo Resource Consultants figure, and 1"=80' for the Caltrans figure.
- Two Site Photos that provide a general idea of the landscape area.


