I just wanted to give you an update on the status of implementation of the Work Plan for Additional Site Characterization for the 6601/6603 Bay Street site in Emeryville. In early October, Sybase submitted access requests and an access agreement to the current property owner of the 6601/6603 Bay Street and 1650 65th Street properties (Griffin Capital). EKI understands that the current property owner is in discussions with its attorney and Sybase

regarding access. However, EKI does not know if and when access will be granted to perform the field work. As such, EKI requests that the deadline to submit the site investigation report be extended from 12/31/09 to 3/31/09.
