Discussion with Michelle King (EKI) and Todd O. Maiden (Reed Smith) about site.

Site constraints precluded going further to the north or south. Michelle believes the hydrocarbons detected in SB-6 were from a different source (the landfill) based on the chromatogram pattern for this sample.

They maintain that the wells are downgradient of the tanks and say that they could not sample to the south of the tanks due to property access issues. The tanks were located right at the property boundary.

We agree to modify the well search to 500 feet of the site.

Discuss vapor intrusion at site. Benzene and Naphthalene will be the primary COCs for vapor intrusion. Michelle mentions that benzene in groundwater is below the ESL for vapor intrusion.
