August 25, 2009

Returned call to Mr. Mooney; Intro self and let him know I've not heard from June, so was returning call to followup. I'd been waiting to see if a call was forth coming. Please call; I can assist with claiming the site in Geotracker.

September 24, 2009

Received VM @ 11:51am from Jim Gribi of Gribi & Assoc. 707.748.7743

He received a call from Ron Mooney and they were wondering what would be required to take the case to closure; please call.

Returned call to Jim @ 1:30. He relays that there were a number of really old USTs (1930's or so) that were allowed to be abandoned in-place by County. They installed 11 – 13 bores to characterize site back in 2000-ish. Wells were last sampled in 2000. They will be sampling in next week or so for the first time since then to comply with Resolution, concentrations were fairly low back then, and it would be good to understand where site groundwater sits now. I let Jim know the "Impediments to Closure" review process required by Resolution 2009-0042 is required and to be done on ALL sites before ANY letters are issued (unless risk, imminent development, 5 year review), so while I'll be reviewing the site fairly soon, it'll take some time before we / I can send a letter.

Ask him to also get site claimed in Geotracker due to NOV to Mr. Mooney. He will, and will get wells surveyed to Geotracker standards and get items uploaded, all planned or proposed work. He'll let Mr. Mooney that there will be a delay, but that the County is "fully" staffed. Great; it would definitely be appreciated.
