Hello Barbara,

Per our telephone discussion this afternoon, this email requests a postponement of groundwater monitoring activities at the subject property until approval of the work plan for additional investigation.

Monitoring of the current well network has been ongoing since January 2007. The data indicates a small area of the property with an observed layer of high viscosity, non-mobile free phase product (FPP). The FPP is currently being treated using hydrophobic socks and a passive FPP collection canister. Groundwater results obtained to date indicate that the groundwater concentrations are stable, and the plume does not appear to be moving. We have proposed additional off-site investigation in a work plan dated 9 March 2009, and request to suspend groundwater monitoring until approval of this work plan.
