- 7/10/96 Left message for Mary Ellen Tucker, Shell Oil, regarding the status of their review of their files on this site.
- 7/15/96 Mary Ellen Tucker, Shell, 1-713-241-4411
Ms. Tucker called back & stated that Shell had their consultants prepare a Phase I to determine whether Shell is responsible for any of the contamination identified at the site.
