Responsible Party Identification Background

Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) names a "Responsible Party," as defined under 23 C.C.R Sec. 2720. Section 2720 defines a responsible party 4 ways. An RP can be:

- 1. "Any person who owns or operates an underground storage tank used for the storage of any hazardous substance."
- 2. "In the case of any underground storage tank no longer in use, any person who owned or operated the underground storage tank immediately before the discontinuation of its use."
- 3. "Any owner of property where an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance from an underground storage tank has occurred."
- 4. "Any person who had or has control over an underground storage tank at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance."

ACEH has named the responsible parties for this site as detailed below.

Responsible Party Identification

Existence of Unauthorized Release

In June 1988 six USTs formerly holding "350 Paint Thinner" were removed from the sidewalk in front of the site. One UST was 6,000-gallons, two were 3,000-gallons, two were 4,000-gallons, and one was 2,000-gallons in size. Prior to that event, in January 1988, soil bores #1 to #12 had been installed adjacent to the USTs, soil samples collected, and concentrations of up to 27,391 mg/kg were documented to be present in soil. These data indicate than an unauthorized release had occurred at the site.

Responsible Party Identification

Frank W. Dunne (Dunne Quality Paints or Frank W. Dunne Co.) owned separate parcels within the property by March 1969 and sold those property parcels in August 1992, and is therefore a former property owner of the site. Frank W. Dunne and Fran W. Dunne Co. are responsible parties for site because they owned multiple USTs used for the storage of a hazardous substance (Definition 1) and they owned the USTs immediately before discontinuation of use (Definition 2), he / it owned the property where an unauthorized release from one or more USTs occurred (Definition 3), and they had control over the USTs at the time of or following an unauthorized release of a hazardous substance (Definition 4).

Chad & Carol McNamee purchased the property in August 1992, is therefore a former property owner of the site. The McNamee's are responsible parties for site because they owned the property where an unauthorized release from one or more USTs occurred (Definition 3).

Green City Lofts LLC purchased the property in May 2003, and is a current property owner of portions of the original parcels, and sold or transferred other portions of the original parcels at various times, and is therefore a current and former property owner of portions of the site. Green City Lofts is a responsible party for site because it owns and owned portions of the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3).

Green City Lofts Homeowners Association purchased or received portions of the former parcels beginning in approximately July 2005, and is therefore a property owner of portions of the site, and represents all homeowners. The Green City Lofts Community Association is a responsible party for site because it owns portions of the property where an unauthorized release has occurred (Definition 3).
