Enclosed is the additional information requested in the letter from your office dated January 11, 2001.

- 1) A completed Unauthorized Release Form is attached.
- ASE could not locate which properties were used to determine the groundwater flow direction at the site at the time of the initial assessment. I believe that the groundwater flow direction was discussed with Larry Seto of your office at the time of the initial assessment. However, the groundwater flow direction is consistently to the southwest at two of ASE's projects located 5 blocks away (approximately 1700-feet from the site) at 726 Harrison Street and 250 8th Street. The distribution of hydrocarbons in the site borings also suggests groundwater flow to the southwest.
- 3) The basement samples were taken approximately 9.7-feet below ground surface (bgs). The samples were collected 1-feet below the basement concrete surface and the floor of the basement is 8'4" below ground surface. If the concrete floor is assumed to be 4" thick, then the samples collected from the beneath the basement would be approximately 9.7-feet bgs.
- 4) ASE could not locate a copy of the well sampling field log for the groundwater sample collected on 7-19-2000. ASE's office copy of the report is missing this field log. ASE has not been able to locate the original copy in our files. Since it is highly unusual for an original document to be missing and a copy to be missing from at least two

copies of a report, it may be possible that the original log went out in a report. Please be assured that all of ASE's standard procedures for wells sampling were followed and that the data from that well sampling is just as reliable as the data from the other sampling periods.

The Salvation Army has informed Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) that it intends to sell its property located at 810 Clay Street, Oakland, California 94604. Since March 1999, ACEH has been the lead agency in connection with the investigation and remediation of soil and groundwater contamination at the site. Over the past three months, Salvation Army has cooperated fully with ACEH, and it has committed to do so in the future.

In approximately 1965, the current structure, which includes a basement was built at the Property. In December 1998, a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) was conducted on the site. Based on historical aerial photographs and business directories, it appeared that a portion of the Property was in use as a gasoline service station from at least 1939 through approximately 1965. No information was found indicating the condition of the underground storage tanks (UGTs), or details regarding their removal from the Property.

Based on the results of the Environmental Site Assessment, in January 1999 a subsurface soil and groundwater investigation was initiated to assess if previous operations at the Property had impacted subsurface conditions. Three(3) Geoprobe borings were advanced in and/or around areas suspected of previously containing underground storage tanks. Soil and groundwater samples were collected. TPH(diesel) was detected in soil and groundwater samples collected from all three borings at concentrations ranging form 3.3 ppm (mg/kg) to 1,000 ppm in soil samples and at concentrations ranging from 380 ppb (ug/L) to 1,000ppb in groundwater samples. TPH(gas) was detected in only the soil sample and groundwater sample collected from SB-1 at concentrations of 3,800 ppm and 610 ug/L, respectively. MTBE was not detected in any soil or groundwater sample submitted for analysis. Benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene and xylenes were detected above method detection limits in samples collected from SB-1. Benzene was detected in samples SB-1 and GW-1 reported at concentrations of 22 ppm and 47 ug/L, respectively.

Low levels of toluene and xylenes were also detected in samples GW-2 and SB-3. Volatile Halocarbons were not detected in any of the soil and groundwater samples submitted for analysis.

In April 1999, an additional subsurface investigation was initiated that consisted of the advancement of two soil borings BH-A and BH-B on the sidewalk adjacent to the building, and four soil borings in the basement of the building. Borings BH-A and BH-B were advanced into groundwater for collection of groundwater samples. A groundwater sample collected from boring BH-B contained 3,100 ppb TPH(gas), 1,000 TPH(diesel), 540 ppb benzene, 250 ppb ethylbenzene and 38 ppb total xylenes.

At this time, with the data and information available to this office, no active remediation is required. Salvation Army was given notice last month from this office that they need to install at least one groundwater monitoring well in the verified downgradient direction. Once the well(s) are installed, a quarterly groundwater-monitoring program will be implemented. After one year of monitoring, the monitoring schedule can be reviewed for modification. Site closure will be granted when the site present no significant risk to the environment and public health.

Alameda County Environmental Health, Local Oversight Program considers Salvation Army to be the primarily responsible party in connection with the remediation of contamination at the site, and Alameda County expects that Salvation Army will continue to implement the current remedial action plan until closure is obtained. The Regional Board does not pursue prospective purchasers where the primarily responsible party has the financial resources necessary to conduct the remediation, and where that responsible party is satisfactorily engaged in active remediation.


