The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) Division of Financial Assistance has received an application for the Orphan Site Cleanup Fund (OSCF) from Terra Green Community Development Corporation for 3820 San Leandro Street, Oakland, CA. This application has been assigned project number B154. Please provide this number when making any inquiries regarding this application.

The Alameda County LOP has been identified by the applicant as the Lead Regulatory Agency to oversee the cleanup of contaminated soil and groundwater from leaking petroleum underground storage tanks at the subject site. As the identified Lead Regulatory Agency, you will receive copies of correspondence sent to the applicant from the OSCF Program.

During our review process, OSCF Program staff will contact you either by telephone or by e-mail to verify applicant information. Once the application review is complete, the applicant will receive either an acceptance or rejection letter. Accepted applications will be placed on the OSCF Priority List in accordance with Section 2814.29 of the OSCA, Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 18, Article 7 of the California Code of Regulations.

The OSCF program was created to encourage the cleanup of "brownfield" petroleum underground storage tank contaminated sites where there is no financially responsible party. These sites represent a special problem because they prevent and delay community cleanup and redevelopment. Due to statutory time limitations the State Water Board will encourage expeditious site assessment and cleanup of approved OSCF projects. Your assistance is requested to help move OSCF funded projects forward toward site cleanup. OSCF Program staff looks forward to working with you on the above project.
