On behalf of ARCO Products Company (ARCO), RESNA Industries Inc. (RESNA) is requesting a street encroachment permit to install and monitor one groundwater monitoring well (MW-7) on the street adjacent to the property located at 1001 San Pablo Avenue in Albany, California (Plate 1) as part of an ongoing offsite subsurface environmental investigation. The proposed groundwater monitoring well will be installed in the sidewalk area on Marin Avenue as shown on Plate 2. After initial installation of the well, it will be monitored on a quarterly basis to determine changes in groundwater levels, and for sampling to determine presence of any gasoline impacted groundwater.

## **Description of Work**

One soil boring (B-23) will be drilled using 10-inch-diameter hollow-stem auger to the depth of approximately 35 feet below ground surface. The monitoring well (MW-7) will be constructed in the boring using clean 2-inch-diameter, thread-jointed, Schedule 40 polyvinyl chloride (PVC) casing. No chemical cements, glues, or solvents will be used in well construction. The casing bottom will be sealed with a threaded end-plug, and the casing top with a locking plug. The screened portion of the well will be constructed of machine-slotted PVC casing with 0.020-inch-wide (typical) slots. The screened section in the groundwater monitoring well will be placed to allow monitoring during seasonal fluctuations of groundwater levels. The annular space of the well will be backfilled with No. 3 sand, to approximately two feet above the top of the screened casing. A 1- to 2-foot-thick bentonite plug will be placed above the sand as a seal against cement entering the filter pack. The

remaining annulus will be then backfilled with a slurry of water, neat cement, and bentonite to approximately one foot below the ground surface. An aluminum utility box with a PVC apron will be placed over the wellhead and set in concrete placed flush with the surrounding ground surface. The wellhead cover will have a seal to protect the monitoring well against surface-water infiltration and requires a special wrench to open. The design discourages vandalism and reduces the possibility of accidental disturbance of the well. Typical monitoring well construction is shown on Plate 3.

The proposed monitoring well will be an important source of information concerning soils and groundwater in the immediate area of ARCO Station 2035 located at 1001 San Pablo Avenue in Albany, California. The installation and maintenance of the well will remain the responsibility of ARCO. A well construction permit will be acquired from Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (ACFCWCD) prior to drilling, and an underground utility line locating company will be contracted to locate underground utilities.

#### Construction Cost

The total cost of drilling and installation of the well is estimated to be \$ 3,200.







# SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FOR WORK IN CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY

This APPLIC	ATION MUST BE ACCOMPANIED by the DATA and PLANS Indicated below:
	APPROVED Construction Plans and/or Documents.  An Engineer's Estimate of the value of all public improvements and utility services within the public right-of-way. The grading estimate (in cubic yards) is to be submitted separately with the Grading Permit.  A Solis Report prepared by a Registered Civil Engineer.
	ALL FEES SHALL BE PAID AND DEPOSITS MADE PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF THIS PERMIT

The following conditions and provisions of the Albany Municipal Code apply to this permit:

#### COMMENCEMENT OF WORK

The permittee shall begin the work or use authorized by a permit issued pursuant to this chapter within ninety (90) days from the date of issuance unless a different period is stated in the permit, or an extension of time is granted by the Director of Public works. If the work or use is not begun accordingly the permit shall become void.

#### **INSPECTION**

In general, inspection procedures, and requirements shall be as established by the Director of Public Works. Unless specifically exempted by the City Code, no encroachment work shall take place without inspection by the Director of Public Works or his authorized agent. Inspections by the City must be requested at least TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS (excluding weekends) IN ADVANCE of the work to be performed. No work shall be performed on weekends without PRIOR AUTHORIZATION of the Director of Public Works.

#### DISPLAY OF PERMIT

A. The permittee shall keep a copy of this permit at the site of the work, or in the cab of a vehicle when movement on a public street is involved. The permit shall be shown to any authorized representative of the Director of Public Works or law enforcement officer on demand.

## **ACCEPTANCE OF PERMIT BY APPLICANT**

Acceptance by the applicant of the permit shall be conclusive evidence of the reasonableness of the terms imposed and shall constitute a waiver of any right to legislative determination thereof.

#### NON-ASSIGNMENT OF PERMIT

Permits shall be issued only to the person making application and may not be assigned to another person by the permittee. If any permittee assigns his permit to another, the permit will be revoked.

#### CHANGES IN PERMIT AND WORK

No changes may be made in the location, dimensions, character, or duration of the encroachment or use as granted by the permit except upon written authorization of the Director or Public Works.

## **EXCAVATION OF PAVED STREETS**

No excavations shall be permitted within the paved area of the public streets unless the applicant can prove to the satisfaction of the Director of Public Works that the following conditions exists:

A. Boring of the utility is not feasible; and

- B. No reasonable alternative utility alignment is available outside the paved street area; and
- C. The cut area and an adjacent area shall be resurfaced as approved by the Director of Public Works. The limits of resurfacing shall be as determined by the Director of Public Works to insure the excavated area blends visually with the surrounding area. The applicant shall be responsible for the replacement of any and all obliterated or removed pavement markers or striping.

#### REVOCATION OF PERMIT

- This encroachment permit may be revoked at any time at the option of the Director of Public Works, whenever;
  - 1. It appears to him that the continuing allowance of the permitted work, whether because of changed conditions or otherwise, interferes with full, adequate or safe public use of the right-of-way involved; or
  - 2. The permittee fails to comply with or violates any city ordinance, city standards, safety regulations, or any condition of the issuance of the permit.
  - 3. Upon revocation of the permit, the permittee shall immediately restore the public right-of-way to a condition as required by the Director of Public Works. If the restoration is not completed within the tim specified by the Director of Public Works the City may take any and all necessary action so required to restore the right-of-way. Any and all costs incurred by the City will be deducted from any deposits posted by the permittee and if necessary recovered by legal action.

#### COMPLETION OF WORK

The permittee must complete the work or use authorized by a permit issued pursuant to this chapter within the time specified in the permit. If at any time the Director of Public Works finds that the delay in the prosecution or completion of the work or use authorized is die to lack of diligence on the part of the permittee, the permit may be revoked.

#### PERMITTEE LIABILITY

he permittee shall agree to hold the City, its officers, and employees harmless from any and all liability, claims, suits or ctions for any and all damages alleged to have been suffered by any person or property by reason of the permittee's installation, operation, maintenance or removal of the encroachment.
