- 8/12/96 Spoke to Ron Brown about getting copies of Forms A+B
- 9/6/96 Left message for Ron Brown requesting copies of Forms A+B
- 9/16/96 Spoke to Ron Brown & requested copies of Forms A+B. He said he would have someone submit them soon.
- 10/3/96 Spoke to Sam Angila, RWALB, who agreed that further characterization is warranted at the site for lead contaminated g.w.
- 10/8/96 Left message for Larry Sato. Told him that Mark Wouat called yesterday & wanted to know why they are still being asked to permit the USTs that they already closed in place. Have already told Kevin Turley 3 times that USTs were already closed in place.
- 10/8/96 Spoke to Mark Wouat. Told him to disregard permit requirements. Discussed lead issue & submittal of Form Bs.
- 1/2/97 Left message for Jim Owens re the status of the work plan submittal
- 1/2/97 Spoke to Jim Owens. He stated he could not find copy of Oct 3 '96 letter. I told him I would fax a copy and jot down a new deadline for Feb ²⁷ 97.

- 7/18/96 Spoke to Mark Wouat → I called him to find out status of tank closure in place. When I spoke to Ron Brown on May 23, '96, I specifically requested that he submit a site figure w/ the sample locations, sample results, & to resubmit the sample w/ lead levels for analysis after filtering. Have not heard back from him since then.
- 7/18/96 Left messages for Ron Brown and Jim Owens re status of tank closure.
- 7/18/96 Ron Brown called & left message so I returned his call & he said he would have to call me back today.
- 7/18/96 Jim Owens called back & said he would comply w/ whatever work is necessary.
- 7/23/96 Ron Brown left me a message.
- 7/23/96 Left Mr. Brown a message (452-5500) requesting that he fax me the sample analysis results for solid & g.w. samples, site figure showing sample locations, filtered lead results, & schedule for tank closure in place.
- 7/25/96 Spoke to RMC Houston re slurry mixture.
- 7/25/96 Meet w/ Ron Brown & Mark Wouat. They will go out to site tomorrow to collect another "grab" g.w. sample, filter it w/ a 0.45 micron filter, & have it analyzed for lead. The results should be in by Monday. They will schedule a time next week to raise the tanks, fill w/ slurry, & close USTs in place. The USTs parts should be filled w/ concrete/cement.
- 7/29/96 Ron Brown called to say that they will fill USTs w/ concrete on Thurs. 8/1/96. They will fax sample results.

Boring SB001 was drilled down to 4' bgs until they hit
what they believe to be UST. Depth of USTs are
not known. Mr. Brown stated that shallow
groundwater exists at the site.

- 4/22/96 Ron Brown → Inquired, they will collect additional
soil samples beneath the USTs to help them decide

wish to close in place, they will be required to install
a well. Soil samples should be analyzed for
lead + edc + edb, in addition to gas + BTEX.
Will bring info to site (certifications).
