Mark Gomez with the City of Oakland identified himself as the new contact for this site. He said the demolition has been delayed, and is now scheduled for the fall 2000. Asbestos and peeling lead base paint is a large problem, more originally anticipated. City of Oakland will submit a workplan to perform a ~~soil~~ surface investigation after the demolition. Gomez will send me a letter documenting our conversation.
