This office has reviewed ProTech Consulting and Engineering's (ProTech) Groundwater Monitor Well Installation, Development, and Sampling & Analysis Report, dated April 1999. Concentrations of chlorinated hydrocarbons (VOCs) in this sampling event have increased in Well MW-4 and have appeared for the first time in Well MW-3 since monitoring began in September 1990. VOC concentrations in Well MW-4 are currently over ten times the California Maximum Contaminant Level Drinking Water Standards (MCLs) for 1,2-Dichloroethane, and are three times the MCLs for cis-1,2-Dichloroethene, Tetrachloroethylene, and Vinyl Chloride. If the VOC concentrations persist or increase in the next monitoring event, further groundwater monitoring and possibly further plume delineation may be required. The San Francisco Bay-Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) is currently requiring that sites with VOC concentrations significantly exceeding the MCLs remain open with active groundwater monitoring. This decision was based on the fact that there is insufficient research data available on VOCs to allow closure of sites with VOC plumes still in place.

Per ProTech's report, Well MW-2 could not be located and further attempts will be made to locate it during the planned re-surfacing work at the site. This office is requesting that a geophysical surveying device be employed at that time to confirm the removal of Well MW-2.

In response to your request in the report, this office finds it acceptable to discontinue the analysis for Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons as gasoline (TPHg), TPH as diesel (TPHd), benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX), and Methyl Tertiary Butyl Ether (MTBE) in future sampling events, based on the NonDetect results that have been identified in the site's wells since sampling began in September 1991. Although Wells MW-1 through MW-4 were screening below the water table in the April 1998 sampling event, these wells appear to have been screening properly across the water table in the initial sampling event in September 1990, when no TPHG, TPHD, or BTEX was identified.

It appears that Wells MW-5 and MW-6 could have been drilled into the backfill material of the former excavation pit. Please submit a site plan in the next groundwater monitoring report showing the existing four wells along with the boundaries of the former tank excavation so that we can confirm whether MW-5 and MW-6 are located in non-native materials.

Lastly, this office received a letter from ProTech on May 27, 1999 requesting that they be allowed to mix the drill cuttings, containing a maximum concentration of 3.9ppm TPHD, from the well installations with site soils during the site's planned re-development. The mixing of these drill cuttings with the site's soils is acceptable to this office.

Susan:

As we discussed, here are the results of sampling after the subject site. A site plan is also attached.

Pit #s 2 & 3 were not sampled because there was no visual evidence of contamination in the pits and the rams were in good condition when removed.

Pit #s 1, 4 and 5 were sampled at approximately 8.5feet below grade (fbg), which is below static water level on-site (approximately 7 fbg), and analyzed for Total Extractible Petroleum Hydrocarbons, characterized as hydraulic oil (TEPH-ho), LUFT metals, and benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX).

All the samples were below detection for BTEX, within acceptable limits for LUFT metals. Pit #s 4 and 5 were also below detection limits for TEPH-ho. Pit #1 contained 500 milligrams/kilogram (mg/kg). A second sample was collected from Pit #1 (Pit #1-2) after soil was removed down to 10.5 fbg and analyzed for TEPH-ho. This sample contained 1400 mg/kg TEPH-ho.

The stockpiled soil sample, SP-1,2,3,4, was also analyzed for TEPH-ho, LUFT metals, BTEX, and volatile organic compounds (VOCs). The results were below detection for BTEX and VOCs, the metals were within acceptable limits, and TEPH-ho was found at 1900 mg/kg.

Kelly-Moore would like permission to close the three pits that were sampled. Pit #4 and 5 were clean, and Pit #1 has been sampled down to approximately 3 feet below static water. There are two groundwater wells on-site and Kelly-Moore plans to install 1 to 2 more wells as they develop the site.

SUBJECT: Monitoring Alternatives for Existing Underground Storage
Tanks

California State law (Health & Safety Code, Section 25280 et seq.) requires all owners/operators of underground storage tanks containing hazardous materials (motor vehicle fuel included) to implement a leak detection monitoring program approved by the local administering agency.

Enclosed please find Table A, which lists the monitoring alternatives available to you in accordance with the California Underground Storage Tank Regulations (CUSTR). Table A lists nine (9) monitoring options and includes a brief description of each. Your monitoring choice will depend on several variables, including: economic feasibility, groundwater conditions, size of tank, frequency of input and withdrawals, and type of product stored.

An accurate assessment of groundwater elevation is necessary, as groundwater conditions may restrict the use of certain monitoring alternatives. Groundwater data may be available through water well drilling logs, local water districts, percolation test records, local Water Quality Control Board data, or U.S.G.S. data. In the absence of any available information, exploratory water borings may have to be performed.

ALTERNATIVE #1 requires a monthly precision test only. However, this alternative could prove to be expansive unless you are considering tank closure in the near future. This option is available to all tank owners.

ALTERNATIVES #2-4 include the installation of a system of monitoring wells; either vapor in dry soils, groundwater in saturated soils, or both. All groundwater monitoring wells must be installed in accordance with the California State Water Well Standards. Well drilling permits are required for groundwater monitoring wells.

ALTERNATIVES #5, #6A, and #6B are limited to motor vehicle fuel tanks only. Although Alternative #5 appears to be the easiest to implement, it should be noted that inventory reconciliation tolerances are strict for this alternative. Motor vehicle fuel tank owners are not limited to Alternatives #5, #6A, and #6B.




