I am writing to send you an update on this site investigation status.

ARCADIS is continuing to work with Alameda County to obtain encroachment permits to install the off-site well in the right-of-way of Seminary Avenue. Although we are closer to obtaining the permit, the investigation will not be able to take place in time to submit the site investigation report by December 31.
