HerSchy Environmental Inc. seeks your permission to conduct soil and groundwater sampling at the premises located on the southeast corner of 62<sup>nd</sup> Street and Marshall Street in Oakland, California. The soil and groundwater sampling has been directed by the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health Services as part of an approved work plan dated November 16, 2006.

The data taken from the sampling at the above-referenced site will be used to determine if there has been underground migration of fuel contaminates resulting from an unauthorized release of gasoline products from the business located at 6211 San Pablo Ave, across the street from your property.

The sampling will be done using a technique whereby a series of small diameter holes are bored into the soil using a truck mounted hydraulic press. Soil and groundwater samples will be collected from the small diameter holes and sent to a laboratory for analysis. The small diameter holes will be capped with material to match the surroundings. The entire duration of on-site work is expected to require one half day or less.

You will not be responsible for costs associated with this one-time sampling event.

If you grant permission to conduct sampling, a HerSchy Environmental Inc representative will contact you to arrange for a mutually convenient sampling date. Your response to this request will be forwarded to Alameda County for inclusion into the ongoing work plan. Alameda County Department of Environmental Health Services handles all cases involving refusal to access approved work plans under their scope of authority.
