On behalf of Chevron Environmental Management Company (Chevron), Stantec Consulting Services Inc. (Stantec) respectfully requests an extension to complete the additional assessment associated with former Chevron-branded service station 90517, which was located at 3900 Piedmont Avenue, Oakland, Alameda County, California (the Site). In a letter dated November 10, 2016, Alameda County Environmental Health (ACEH) requested additional assessment with a report due by January 27, 2017.

Chevron has recently come to an understanding with the on-site property owner regarding the execution of future assessment activities, and the property owner provided Chevron with the new tenant information. Chevron and Stantec will be coordinating with the tenant prior to resuming assessment activities. To allow time for this coordination and subsequent assessment activities, Stantec respectfully requests that an extension be granted for the investigation report to be submitted to ACEH by April 28, 2017.
