Hello Jerry,

Just a notice that the Fourth Quarter 2008 Groundwater Monitoring Report and Annual Summary Report has been uploaded to Geotracker and the Alameda County server.

In this report, we also recommended that this site be considered by Alameda Environmental Health to be moved from quarterly to semi-annual monitoring (Q1 in March and Q3 in September). We think that after 41 quarterly monitoring events since 1997, there is a fairly distinctive trend of seasonally high contaminant detections in groundwater in Q3 and lows in Q1.

I mentioned in an earlier email that the property owner has told me that they will try to initiate

SVE remediation this June or July, however the site's Tank Fund LOC has just been suspended so I suspect that they will need to postpone SVE. Either way, when we do advance with SVE, we would return to a quarterly monitoring schedule.
