This letter summarizes our meeting, dated January 21, 1993, in regards to the installation of two monitoring wells.

Soil Tech Engineering, Inc. (STE), on behalf of Mr. Murray Stevens, agreed to install two monitoring wells down-gradient of wells STMW-1 and STMW-3. The location of proposed wells are shown in attached site plan.

The wells will be installed in accordance with local guidelines and accordance with our Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) which include local and state guidelines.

For more detail of drilling, soil sampling, well development, water sampling and Health & Safety Plan, please see our work plan, dated August 30, 1990.

Furthermore, it is our understanding that additional wells will be installed by Clayton Environmental Consultants in the vicinity of Big 5 Store to investigate the possible leakage from the hydraulic lift and waste oil tank of former Goodyear Store.


We will initiate the field work by February 2, 1993. If you have any questions or require additional information, please feel free to contact our office at your convenience.
