Our investigation is overseen by the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA).

As part of this investigation, we are requesting access to install one air monitoring probe in the rear portion of your property. Our proposed work would involve approximately 3 workers over one 8-hour day to install the probe, followed by one person accessing the probes for sampling for approximately 1 to 2 hours once every three months. The probe installation involves hand digging vertically down several feet to install the probe. Once the probe is installed, we will secure the probe with a metal cover flush to the ground. Since the entire probe is installed below ground surface, the probe should not cause any interference with use of that portion of the property. We can also work with you to minimize any disruption during probe installation or sampling.

Attached, please find a standard access agreement for general investigation and remediation work. Please review the language in the agreement, and let us know if you require any changes or conditions in order to execute the agreement. We would also like to request a meeting at 2721 Martin Luther King Jr. Way to discuss the access and probe installation.
