Our investigation is overseen by the Alameda County Health Care Services Agency (ACHCSA).

As part of this investigation, we are requesting access to install one monitoring well in the parking lot of your property. Our proposed work would involve approximately 3 workers over two 4-hour days to install the well, followed by one person accessing the well for sampling for approximately 1 to 2 hours once every three months. The well installation involves drilling vertically down several feet to install the well. Once the well is installed, we will secure the well with a metal cover flush to the ground. Since the entire well is installed below ground surface, the well should not cause any interference with use of that portion of the property. We can also work with you to minimize any disruption during well installation or sampling.

Attached, please find a standard access agreement for general investigation and remediation work. Please review the language in the agreement, and let us know if you require any changes or conditions in order to execute the agreement.
