Jerry,

Our November 2007 work plan proposed the installation of 5 offsite monitoring wells and 2 offsite soil vapor probes – the attached map shows the proposed locations. Your December 5, 2007 approval letter set a report due date for these activities as May 8, 2008.

As noted in the work plan, four separate access agreements were required prior to implementing this work plan. I've summarized each required access agreement and our progress below:

Wells MW-9, MW-10, MW-11, and vapor probe VP-10 – These are to be installed on the school property. Our original access agreement was specific to our previous scope of work. We are working with the school to get the new scope of work approved by their Board of Directors. They have requested we start in July. We currently have this work scheduled for July 22nd through 24th.

Vapor Probe VP-9 – We have obtained an access agreement, and will complete the probe installation in July with the work at the school.

MW-13 – No response has been received. We will send an additional request and keep you updated.

MW-15 – The property owner has indicated he is amenable to allowing access. We will keep you posted, and attempt to include this well installation with the July work.

Based on this, we'd like to request a due date extension for the report to September 22 – 60 days after the

currently scheduled field work. This report will include, at a minimum, activities relating to the installation of wells MW-9, MW-10, and MW-11, and vapor probes VP-9 and VP-10.
