Hi Mark,

As we discussed last week, we were unable to drill in the parking lane or sidewalk on Jefferson Street due to utilities. However, we will be able to advance borings in the right lane of the west side of Jefferson Street without any utility interference. A traffic control plan will take up to 3 weeks for approval from the City of Oakland. We'd like to request a 45 to 60 day extension for the report submittal to accommodate this waiting period for City approval since we won't be able to remobilize for the drilling until at least the 3rd week of June.
