Had long and extended discussion on the need for MTBE analysis from downgradient wells. He is concerned that if MTBE is found in those wells he would be responsible for cleanup and pointed to a number of sites to his south that could have contributed. I tell him it is very unlikely we'd be able to do much at that distance, but review with him vicinity sites (especially one upgradient (Owens Brockway Glass). None appear to have MTBE as a contaminant; however, he does (or did). Discuss USTCF reimbursement – he was in the fund and if his LOC has been rescinded he should be able to reapply to recover some of his costs (he is living on disability). He lets me know he just received our letter, address is backwards, got from Ken Price of ERS, so may need more time. I also let him know that if he can object in writing and we'll review it again, but that I would remain on the case. He discussed his father's well that was 8 ft from a chrome dumping site, but wasn't tested. And I relay that is why we are asking for this extra effort; we've realized that there are a lot of residential wells in the area, and that they need some level of protection.
